— Pre-Audit Checklist: What You'll Need

Also, have your work order history and parts inventory ready—along with a full asset inventory list that shows each vehicle's location and status.

Audits can go off track fast due to missing or incomplete maintenance records, outdated or expired registrations, or inconsistent odometer readings. Manual data entry and unverified fuel transactions are red flags too—invest in systems that reduce risk.
